DAY 03

Sun 25 February FULL DAY CAIRO – PYRAMIDS, SPHINX, SAQQARA

Today we travel back to ancient Egypt with a full day of touring to the wonders of the ancient world, some of which date back to 1000+ years prior to Abraham. We spend time at one of the Seven Wonders of the world, the famous pyramids. Cheops. We will also see the Sphinx, Saqqara is one of the most extensive archaeological sites in Egypt and is dominated by the Step Pyramid of King Zoser, one of the oldest stone structures in the world! We then take a short drive to the south to Faiyum, the region created Joseph where you will see numerous ancient structures. Dinner and overnight in Cairo. (B,D)







Mon 26 February CAIRO TO LUXOR, BOARD CRUISE, LUXOR

A very early start today. After an early breakfast we transfer to the airport for our flight to Luxor aboard Egypt. Upon our arrival we will visit the Temple of Karnak with the statues of Amon before boarding our ship in time for lunch. This evening we take a visit to the Temple of Luxor whilst illuminated and stroll through the city corniche. Dinner and overnight on board our ship. (B,L,D)





DAY 04













Tues 27 February LUXOR, EDFU

This morning we enjoy a visit to the West Bank of the Nile and the Two Colossi of Memnon, Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir-El-Bahri and the Valley of Kings. We return to the ship for lunch and continue sailing via Esna Lock to Edfu. Dinner and overnight on board. (B,L,D)











Wed 28 February EDFU, KOM UMBO

This morning is a free morning in Edfu. You may wish to take a visit to the Temple of Edfu or just relax and take in the surroundings. Later we set sail for Kom Umbo and enjoy lunch onboard. At Kom Umbo we visit the temples established during the Ptolemaic dynasty. We return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)



DAY 07

Thurs 29 February TEMPLE OF PHILAE, ELEPHANTINE ISLAND, AGA KHAN

A free morning to relax, or the possibility to join an optional trip to Abu Simbel (extra cost). After lunch the afternoon is spent at the High Dam and the Island Temple of Philae. Later we will take a pre-sunset felucca ride (traditional sailing vessel) around Elephantine Island and Agha Khan Mausoleum. Enjoy dinner and our last night onboard our cruise. (B,L,D)




Sun 3 March AMMAN, PETRA

This morning after breakfast, our first stop will be Mt. Nebo to view the site where Moses viewed the Promised Land before his passing. Drive to Wadi Ram, the setting of Lawrence of Arabia for an exciting jeep tour of the magnificent red desert of Edom. Enjoy a Bedouin lunch (included). Proceed to our Petra hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)








Mon 4 March PETRA, AQABA, EILAT

This morning in we set out to explore Petra! Travel by foot through the awesome "CIQ" valley. Visit the Treasury and explore hundreds of buildings, tombs, temples and a 3,000-seat theatre from the first century AD. Those who'd like to proceed to the Monastery and High Place may do so. Lunch, drinks, and snacks can be purchased at one of the many cafes in the Petra Site at own cost. Optional horse or horse and chariot ride back to the entrance, this process will be explained on site. In the afternoon we depart before making our way to Aqaba on the Red Sea to cross the border into Israel. Where our Israeli tour guide and driver will greet us. Proceed by coach to our hotel in Eilat by the Red Sea. Stroll the adjacent beachfront or nearby shopping mall after dinner. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Eilat (B, D)







Tues 5 March EILAT, TABERNACLE IN THE WILDERNESS

Late start this morning to sleep in, or enjoy a lazy breakfast by the Red Sea. At 10am we will arrive at the Eilat Coral Beach Nature Reserve to enjoy the water views and for an optional morning snorkel session to see the beautiful corals and tropical fish in the clear pristine water of the Red Sea, just a mile from the Egyptian border. Facemasks and snorkel gear can be hired from the national park Kiosk and there are good showers and changing room facilities. After stopping for a light lunch (own cost), we travel to Timna Park to see the Tabernacle in the Wilderness with a guided. Afterwards we return to Eilat for optional local shopping or relaxing in or around the pool. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Eilat. (B,D)








Wed 6 March MITZPE RAMON, BEER SHEVA, TEL AVIV

We will check out of our hotel in Eilat, and then drive north along the Arava desert valley for a brief stop at the Ramon crater to enjoy the amazing view. Shortly after we'll stop (Advat roadhouse) for lunch (own cost). We'll briefly visit the new Anzac Museum before finally arriving at Tel Aviv at our beautiful hotel right on the beach for a wonderful buffet dinner and sunset over the Mediterranean Sea. (B,D)





DAY 7

Thurs 7 March CAESAREA, MT. CARMEL (MUHRAKA), MEGIDDO, NAZARETH



Today we journey up the coast to Caesarea Maritima and its spectacular ruins. We will see a short presentation (if space and time is available) and stop briefly at the nearby ancient aqueduct. Next stop is Mt. Carmel for a delicious falafel lunch (included) then to the site Elijah performed great exploits. We'll drive into the Jezreel Valley (Megiddo) to visit the ruins of Tel Megiddo and afterward, make our way to Nazareth Village for a tour to see what life was like for Yeshua growing up. If time permits, we will take a drive up to Mt. Precipice for a sunset discussion on how the locals tried to throw Yeshua off the cliff. Then we make our way to our hotel, located on the shores of the Sea of Galilee in Tiberias for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)



Fri 8 March MT OF BEATITUDES, CAPERNAUM, SEA OF GALILEE BOAT RIDE, YARDENIT

Our day today is spent all around the beautiful Sea of Galilee. We will visit the Mt. of Beatitudes where Yeshua preached the Sermon on the Mount. Capernaum, Yeshua's home-town during the majority of His ministry years is our next port of call. Then we will visit the Primacy of Peter, on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Afterward, we will visit the 1st century fishing boat at Nof Ginosar and enjoy a time of sailing in a boat on the Sea of Galilee, followed by a delicious St Peters fish lunch (included). To finish off our day, we will drive to Yardinet on the Jordan River for those desiring to be water baptised before heading back to our hotel for dinner and overnight (B, L, D)














Sat 9 March MT ARBEL, BANIAS, **GOLAN HÉIGHTS**

This morning, we drive to Mt. Arbel for a morning walk to the top to see the views of the Galilee and then head north to Tel Dan, which was 1 of 2 sites where idolatry was established by King Jeroboam. Next stop is Banias (Caesarea Philippi), where Yeshua asked His disciples an incredibly important question. We then make our way for a quick stop for to buy lunch (own cost) at the Druze restaurant with views of Mt Hermon as we make our way through the Golan Heights and If time permits, we will ascend Mount Bental to view across the border into Syria and discuss an area particularly important and strategic for Israel's safety and security, perhaps enjoy a guick coffee at the kiosk. We then check-in at our beautiful kibbutz hotel in the upper Galilee for Shabbatt dinner and overnight. (B,D)

BEIT SHEAN, SACHNE, QASR EL YAHUD, DEAD SEA

We depart the Galilee this morning and drive to Beit Shean, the capital city of the Decapolis which has incredible ruins and interesting New Covenant history. Afterwards we will enjoy a picnic lunch (included) in the beautiful Sachne parklands. We will drive down the Jordan Valley into the wilderness region to Qasr El Yahud, the actual site of Yeshua's baptism and close out our day at the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth! Floating in the salty water is an experience you cannot afford to miss! Enjoy dinner and overnight at our hotel on the shores of the Dead Sea. (B.L.D)



Mon 11 March MASADA, EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, JERUSALEM

Today we will cover some incredible history, beginning with King Herod's Mountain fortress on Masada. Then we will stop at Ein Gedi, the oasis in the desert that was so important to King David and his men. Next stop is Qumran, where the most important archaeological discoveries in modern history were found! Finally, the moment we have been waiting for...we will drive up to Jerusalem, the Holy City of God! Enjoy dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)



Tues 12 March CITY OF DAVID, YAD HASHMONA, BIBLICAL DINNER

After breakfast, we will be privileged to walk through portions of the City of David and through Hezekiah's Tunnels, the very site where Jerusalem first became Israel's capital. We then head back to the Old City to walk to the Southern Steps where Yeshua taught, and see the many ritual baths in the ruins. We continue to the Western Wall (Wailing Wall), where Jews for the past 2000 years desired to pray facing the site where the Temple used to stand. We will explore the Western Wall Tunnels, which lead down to the very Herodian Street of Yeshua's day and finally, end our day at Yad Hashmona on the outskirts of Jerusalem to share a unique and special Biblical meal together. After dinner, we will return to our hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)





DAY 13

Wed 13 March ISRAEL MUSEUM, YAD VASHEM, SOUND & LIGHT SHOW

We begin our day at the Israel Museum to see the scale of model of Jerusalem of Yeshua's days we will also see some of the famous Dead Sea Scrolls we learned about at Qumran. Visit the nearby Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum, which is very sobering but incredibly important. There are a growing number of voices around the world denying the Holocaust ever happened and it is important we never, ever forget the truth. We will visit the famous Menorah across from the Knesset, Israel's Parliament. After dinner, we will see the Tower of David Sound and Light Show. This spectacular show is not to be missed! (B,D)







Thurs 14 March SHILO, MT GERIZIM, BETHEL

This morning we will meet our local guide and driver to commence our touring arrangements after breakfast. Subject to the security situation, today is spent in the Biblical heartland of Samaria. We will visit Shilo, Mount Gerezim and Bethel. Return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B,D)



Fri 15 March MT OF OLIVES, OLD CITY, VIA DOLOROSA, MT ZION, MT SCOPUS

After breakfast today, we visit the Mt. of Olives for a breathtaking view of the Holy City before we begin the descent down the Palm Sunday Road as we walk to Dominus Flevit, where Yeshua wept over the city. Further down, we will come to the Gethsemane private garden where He agonised in prayer just prior to His arrest. We then enter the Old City to the Pools of Bethesda where Yeshua healed the crippled man, and afterward a short walk we will begin our way along the Via Dolorosa. We will leave the Old City through Zion Gate and finish up the day at the Mt Scopus War Memorial Cemetery where many of the ANZACs are buried. (B,D)











Sat 16 March HERODIAN, BETHLEHEM OUTLOOK, GARDEN TOMB

This morning after breakfast, we will begin our day with a stunning view of the Shepherds Fields near Bethlehem before continuing to the Herodian fortress built by King Herod. We will then proceed to the Garden Tomb to celebrate communion together. We will see that the Tomb is indeed empty because He is risen indeed! (B,D)

DAY 17

Sun 17 MarchDEPART JERUSALEM

This morning after breakfast and leisurely check out, we can enjoy the morning for pendent touring and last-minute shopping.
